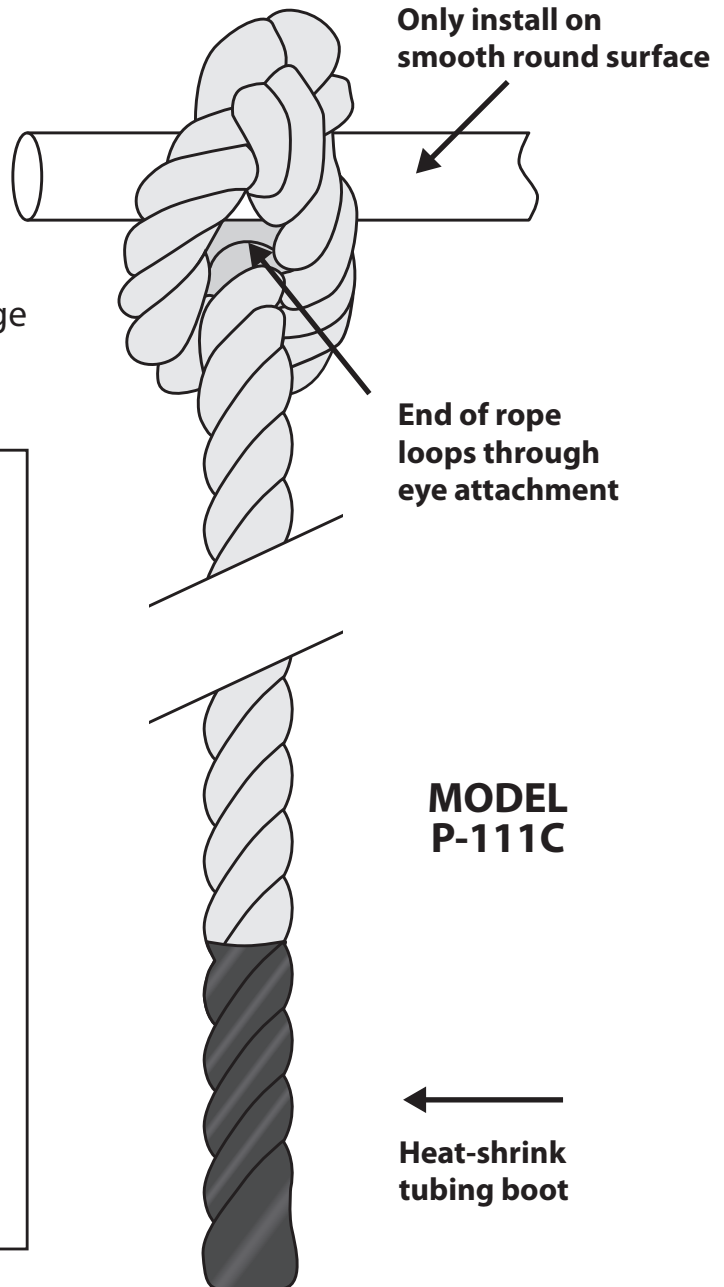


Loop Over Rope Installation

Installation of ropes with rope eye attachment

- Install on smooth round surface
- Insert boot end of rope through eye
- Inspect frequently for wear or damage
- Discard at any wear or damage



The following safety tag information is on every rope:

DO NOT REMOVE SAFETY REMINDER TAG

Indoor climbing nets and ropes require: experienced supervision; proper spotting for each climber; mats around climbing area; and thick landing mats directly under rope.

- **DO NOT JUMP FROM ROPE**
- **DO NOT SWING**
- **BE SURE FEET ARE FIRMLY ON GROUND BEFORE RELEASING FROM ROPE**
